

Explore Your 2.4 with Geocaching!



In celebration of Earth Day, My PATH Program and Forest Green School students challenge their Stony Plain peers to get outside, get active, and have fun with geocaching!

Step #1: Download the Geocaching® app on a portable electronic device and set up a free account.

Not sure what to do from here? The app offers tutorials. Simply go to the "Help Center" which can be found in the "More" menu.

Step #2: Type in your location or select "Current Location". A map will pop up revealing all the caches hidden in this area. Click on the cache icons on the map for details about each cache.

The My PATH Program and Forest Green School students have hidden 5 of these caches: Tree Huggers 1, 2, and 3, Bluebirds 1, and Forest Green - Grade 4. However, there are more out there to find!

Step #3: Plan some time to get outside and find those caches!

Each cache contains a log book to sign and items for trading. Add your school name and class to the log book, please. Don't forget to log your find on the app as well!
