Opportunity:

The Health and Physical Education Teacher position will support Oski Pasikoniwew Kamik (Bigstone Community School) in teaching K-9 health and physical education, and may support additional schools in Treaty 8 throughout the school year. With the guidance of Ever Active Schools, you will also play a key role in the delivery and coordination of support to school communities in a variety of ways such as professional learning opportunities. In addition, this position will engage with Ever Active Schools supported health promotion programs and strategies, such as AMA Youth Run Club or intramural programs, in the best interest of student and community well-being. This position may consider a condensed work week so that while the successful candidate is working in the community, they can fully maximize their time and capacity. The successful candidate has school based experience in teaching Health and Physical Education.

As a partner to Bigstone Cree Nation, Ever Active Schools is supporting the community to source a passionate and committed Health and Physical Education Teacher. The successful candidate will have the opportunity to work alongside the community in a good way, and experience and honour Indigenous ways of being and knowing.

This position reports to the Assistant Director, Ever Active Communities and complements a team of other consultants with diverse skill sets operating within the larger interdisciplinary team of EAS.

This position requires teaching experiences, innovative leadership, strong interpersonal skills, knowledge of physical literacy, cultural sensitivity and an understanding of wellness-related work (health promotion). The individual must be able to travel throughout Alberta, specifically to Bigstone Cree Nation, and expect to be in the community for consecutive days per week dependent on FTE. The successful candidate is motivated to work in a fast-paced, exciting and fun environment. Work days and hours will depend on school need and location of successful applicant.

Duties and Responsibilities:

- Teaching of Health and Physical Education in Oski Pasikoniwew Kamik (Bigstone Community School) in Bigstone Cree Nation and may support additional schools in Treaty 8 throughout the school year
- Work alongside the school in building capacity in the areas of wellness and the subject of health and physical education
- Develop and maintain meaningful partnerships with provincial and First Nations school authorities, municipalities and allied health and education partners, to provide support for existing initiatives and work with communities to address their unique needs.

- Collaborate within and across Ever Active Schools teams and provincially across sectors to promote school based wellness initiatives
- Support overall work of the organization through activities such as events and learning opportunities, and resource development

Qualifications and Experience:

- Bachelor degree in Education; Health and Physical Education training is an asset
- Current Alberta teaching certificate an asset
- A minimum of 1 to 3 years of experience in a school, community or health promotion setting
- Experience leading a project from start to finish is an asset
- Valid Alberta Class 5 driver's license

Candidates must be willing and able to travel occasionally throughout Alberta, and include evenings, and weekends.
