The Edmonton Public Library lends [Air Beam Air Monitor](#) kits. Borrow one to assess the air quality around your school site.

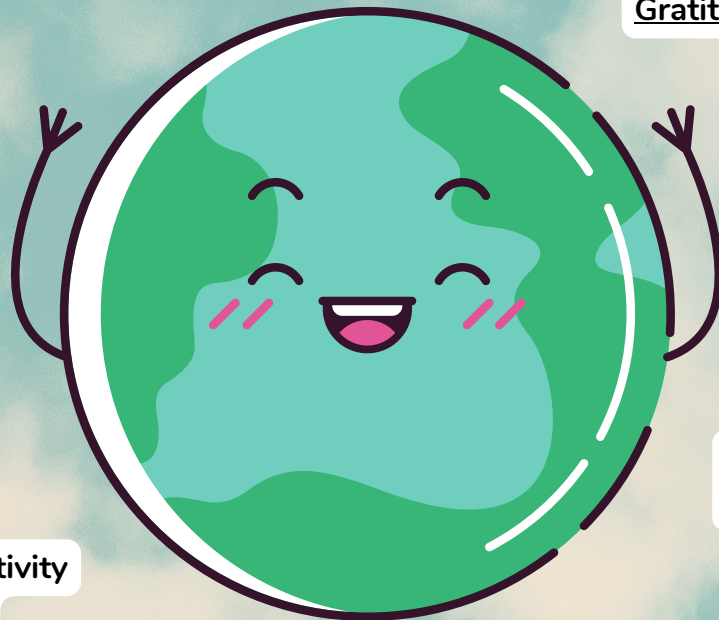
