EAS Street Team is a pilot project in collaboration with a new experiment through <u>Volunteer Alberta</u> called CNIP (Community Nonprofit Internship Program Pilot), which was inspired by the original Serving Community Internship Program (SCiP) that ended in 2019. Volunteer Alberta facilitated the original SCiP for several years with great success, granting bursaries to volunteers attending post-secondary schools across Alberta as an incentive and reward for their generous service.

SCiP was a vital part of Alberta's healthy voluntary sector and we're excited to test this new iteration.

Today, volunteerism is at record lows across Canada. Take advantage of this incentive to engage, and build valuable workplace experience.

#### **Internship Details:**

- Post-secondary students will be selected to complete 10-20 internship positions September 2023 June 2024
  - Each intern will be matched with EAS project(s) in their area. Projects may include:
    - AMA Youth Run Club
    - Everybody Plays
    - Resettlement Through Recreation
    - Research & Evaluation
    - Office Administration
    - Events
    - Indigenous Youth Mentorship Program
    - Active School Travel & Active Transportation
- Interns will develop a variety of the following skills depending on the role and responsibilities within each project:
  - Event coordination and planning
  - Leadership and communication

- Time management and organization
- Community engagement and networking
- Adaptability and problem solving
- Cultural awareness
- Data collection
- Collaboration with education and community partners

#### Successful completion of the internship requires:

- Spend a minimum of 20-40 hours of project support, in addition to completing 10-20 hours of enrollment, training and monitoring requirements
- Complete mandatory reporting requirements through Volunteer Alberta portal
- Remain in good standing for the duration of the volunteer commitment
