# Colouring Contest

## Ever Active Schools is hosting a cover photo contest!

This is your chance to have your photo or artwork featured on this year's Shaping the Future (STF) merch, and shared throughout the conference. Youth can submit their image and 2-5 sentences about what it means to them. The winner will receive \$500 to support health and wellbeing in their school, and their artwork featured on STF 2025 merch.

- **Theme:** What does a healthy school community mean to me? / What does Shaping the Future look like?
- **Deadline:** August 31, 2024 at 11:59pm
- **Who can enter:** Students in grades K-12 in Alberta
- **What can I submit?:** Any kind of still visual art. Digital and film photography, paintings, drawings, digital art, etc. Anything that can be printed!
- **Accepted file types:** .jpg, .jpeg, .png, .pdf, .eps
- **Final file size:** 7:9 ratio (will be printed at 8.5" x 11"), less than 2mb
- **What else do I need to submit?:** Signed PIPA forms (for the artist as well as any people featured in the artwork), your artwork file, and a 2-5 sentence description explaining your artwork and the meaning behind it.
- **Grand prize:** \$500 cheque and feature both on Shaping the Future 2025 merchandise and throughout the conference

So, how do you get started?

- Think about what you love about your school community. What makes your school a healthy place to learn and grow? Who are the people at your school that support you? Use this to inspire your work and to help describe it.
- If you get stuck, ask your friends, family and classmates for help. They can critique your work or discuss ideas, as long as you are the one to create the art.
- We are not looking for perfection. If you feel inspired to create in a way that you are not a master at, that's ok! Give it your best shot.
- Get creative!
