Alberta School Board Policy Clinic

Navigating Alberta's Gender Policy Legislation through a Student Wellbeing and Human Rights Approach



What?

A learning series of four online 2-hour workshops tailored for Alberta school board leaders. This series will offer a collaborative environment for in-depth learning and dialogue among various educational leaders, academics and human rights experts. The clinic will address how school boards can align with evolving legislation while prioritizing student well-being, safety, and inclusivity for every student in the school communities.

Why?

The clinic's purpose is to empower school boards to understand and fulfill their human rights obligations while promoting student well-being in their communities. Participants will have the opportunity to hear from legal experts specializing in human rights, policy scholars with specific expertise in gender and sexual diversity policy, the Ever Active Schools team, and more. Participants can expect to gain a detailed understanding of Bills 27 and 29, their implications for Alberta School Boards, and the ways in which school boards can write quality policy to promote student well-being within their communities while also following the legislative requirements. Additionally, participants will leave the four part series with a policy framework to support prioritizing and actioning required amendments and/or policy development.

Who?

This workshop is designed for system education leaders and policymakers committed to enhancing student well-being and ensuring equitable practices within their schools. Participants may include:

- Trustees
- System administrators
- Inclusive education and/or well-being leads
- Legal and/or policy advisors
- Close school health partners (e.g. AHS)

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Investment?

The total cost per school board is \$3500, which includes:
